13835 Aberdeen Street NE, Ham Lake, MN 55304

From the North: I-35 south to CR-2 exit, EXIT 131, toward US-8/FOREST LAKE. Turn RIGHT onto W BROADWAY AVE/CR-2 W and go 6.9 miles. Turn LEFT onto LEXINGTON AVE NE/CR-17/CR-18 and continue for 4.8 miles. Turn RIGHT onto BUNKER LAKE BLVD NE/CR-116 W, for 3.5 miles. Turn RIGHT onto ABERDEEN ST NE for 1 block. Facility is on the right.

From the South: I-35W north. Merge onto US-10 W via EXIT 30 toward ANOKA for 2.8 miles. EXIT on HWY 65 (Central Ave) and turn RIGHT traveling for 6.1 miles. Turn RIGHT at BUNKER LAKE BLVD. Turn LEFT on ABERDEEN ST. NE for 1 block. Facility is on the right.

From the East: Take I-94 to I-35W NORTH. Merge onto US-10 W via EXIT 30 toward ANOKA for 2.8 miles. EXIT on HWY 65 (Central Ave) and turn RIGHT traveling for 6.1 miles. Turn RIGHT at BUNKER LAKE BLVD. Turn LEFT on ABERDEEN ST. NE for 1 block. Facility is on the right.

From St Cloud: Take Hwy 10 EAST 49 miles. Take the CR-14/MAIN ST exit, turn LEFT. Turn LEFT onto COON CREEK BLVD NW/CR-18 N for 1.6 miles. Turn RIGHT on BUNKER LAKE BLVD and travel 4.7 miles. Turn LEFT on ABERDEEN ST NE for 1 block. Facility is your right.

Dogs is measured while in a standing position on a flat surface . The measurement is taken from the top of the dog's withers. All dogs, except the 26 & 22 inch divisions and the 20inch Select, must have an official measurement when at their first show. If your official dog's measurement moves you into a different height than the one entered, you must notify the show secretary and your dog will be moved.

AWARDS

For all Classes except Nursery classes – 1st Place Ribbons and Clear Round Ribbons

A qualifying Score must be gained to be awarded a Ribbon.

For all Nursery Classes, only Clear Round Ribbons will be awarded.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS (Please read)

UK Agility International Rules and Regulations apply to the whole event and all people and dogs must comply with these at all times. As a competitor it is your responsibility to be aware of the rules and regulations as they stand at the time of the show. This show will run under the 2010 UK Agility International rules.

All dogs and handlers must be registered with UK Agility International in order to compete. UK Agility International's official rules & regulations are given free on registration of Handler/Owner to UKI. If you or your dog is not already registered, fill out the UKI registration form included in this schedule and add the registration fee to your entry fee.

Competitors through submission of entry acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of **UK Agility International rules and regulations** including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry:

Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the day of the Show are not eligible to compete in UK Agility International Trials, with the exception of dogs over 15 calendar months of age eligible to compete in Nursery Classes & Speed Stakes.

Entries without fees paid in full will be returned. Separate entry forms must be completed by each Competitor and must be signed by the Competitor or Guardian if the competitor is a minor. Entry forms must be accompanied with the appropriate fees. If you use a recorded delivery service, you must specify No Signature Required.

Refund Policy Entries will not be accepted, changed or altered after the closing date or capping level has been reached except for the purpose of moving to a higher level. A full refund is available for any membership that is not older than 14 days from the creation of the account date. A full refund is available before the closing date or capping level is met for any show. There will be no cost if refund money is to be left in your UK Agility International account. If money is to be returned then the following administration costs will be incurred. If payment was received by check or money order then a \$4 administration fee will be incurred. If payment was received by credit card a 3% charge of the refund will be assessed, per transaction. If payment was received from a PayPal account, a 5% charge of the refund will be assessed, per transaction.

Once a show has been closed and/or capped, refunds will not be available except for an injury/illness or a bitch in season. A vet note must be provided to the Show Manager prior to the start of the trial to receive a partial refund in MAC vouchers

There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn and neither in the event a dog and/or handler is dismissed from the competition, regardless of the reason for dismissal providing this was within accordance of UK Agility International rules and regulations.

It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Handlers working more than one dog in a class **must ensure that the dogs compete in the sequence in which they are drawn**. Failure to do so will result in elimination.

It is expressly understood that **Competitors alone are responsible** for the behavior of their dogs, children and guests. Any competitor whose dogs, children, or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may at the discretion of the show management, be asked to remove the offending dogs, children, guests from the event grounds. No refunds of fees will be made in such a case.

No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.

No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the show.

Should a judge be unable to fulfill the appointment to judge, the show management reserves the right to appoint another judge. Should circumstances so dictate the show manager, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to UK Agility International. In the event of abandonment of the show through circumstances beyond our control, the SHOW MANAGEMENT may defray such expenses from the entry fee to cover the cost of the show preparation. These accounts will then be made public.

All dogs are entered at this show at their owners risk and whilst every care will be taken the show management will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the show.

All competitors **MUST** clean up after their dogs at all times. Failure to do so will result in competitors being asked to leave the Show.

Dogs left in hot cars, or dogs appearing to be in distress, will be dealt with as seen fit by the Show Management.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. **There will be a \$25.00 service charge for returned checks**. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made before a competitor may compete. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls to a UK Agility International account must be paid prior to the start of the event. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice shall be reported to UK Agility International. UK Agility International will suspend a dog's/handlers registration until fees are paid in full. If your UK Agility International account owes money when we process the entries for this show your running orders may be withheld to encourage you to visit the secretaries tent at the show so that the account balance can be resolved.

Try Before You Buy! Registration Details TBYP will allow you to enter your first UKI trial and pay for that Entry either online or by sending a check, and if after your first UKI trial, you would like to keep your membership with UKI, payment for registration will be due 7 working days after that trial. You will then be sent your registration documents, including your rule and record books. The competitor must first create an account, through our web page (or by paper registration) and must notify us by emailing info@ukagilityinternational.com of their wish to do a TBYP. This means they will not have to pay immediately for their membership with UKI, or at all should they decide not to enter any other shows and do not want to keep any points they earned towards their titles. If the TBYP is submitted using paper registration, the UKI office will create an account for you. When registration is due, the amount will be charged at the higher paper registration fee (\$15 handler membership and \$15 dog membership). An online account cannot then be created later by the competitor for the discounted online fee. Therefore, it is in the competitor's best interest to create an ONLINE account in the first place so when the competitor decides to keep their membership, they will have received the (\$12 handler membership fee and the \$12 dog membership fee).
