DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

From the East:

494 to 35E. South on 35E to County Road 42 exit. Right on County road 42 to Burnsville Parkway. Left (South) on Burnsville Parkway to 145th St. Right on 145th to Soccer Blast. About 1 ½ blocks down 145th on the left.

From the South:

35W to County Road 42 exit. Left (West) on county Road 42 to Burnsville Parkway. Left (South) on Burnsville Parkway to 145th St. Right on 145th to Soccer Blast. About 1 ½ blocks down 145th on the left.

From the North

From the North: 35W to County Road 42 exit. Right (West) on County Road 42 to Burnsville Parkway. Left (South) on Burnsville Parkway to 145th St. Right on 145th to Soccer Blast. Soccer Blast is about 1 ½ blocks down 145th on the left.

From the West:

494 to 169 South. South on 169, follow signs to Savage, (Hwy 13). At the stoplight turn right and go South on Hwy. 13. Take Hwy 13 to County Road 42. Turn left (East) on County Road 42. Take CR 42 to Burnsville Parkway. Turn right (south) on Burnsville Parkway to 145th St. Right on 145th to Soccer Blast.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Below is a brief summary of NADAC rules. Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs. Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.

The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond control of the organizing committee.

Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.

**Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.

- Dogs must enter the Veterans Division in all jumping classes after their 9th birthday. After their 12th birthday, dogs must enter the Skilled Category, Veterans Division for jumping classes and Skilled Category for non-jumping classes.
- **NON-JUMPING CLASSES – VETERAN OR DISABLED HANDLER** Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the non-jumping classes only. The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course. When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Standard Division jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.
- **Proficient/Skilled Categories:** Each class is split into two categories, Proficient and Skilled. In the Skilled Category, dogs must jump 4" lower than indicated by the current jump height table. (No dog may jump less than 4"). In the Regular Agility class, dogs entered in either the Proficient or Skilled Categories may incur 5 or fewer faults, and earn a 5 pt. qualifying round.
- The organizing committee may refuse an entry on the basis provided through NADAC rules and regulations or those established by NADAC board of directors. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed entry into the trial.
- **Measuring:** All dogs entered in the Proficient Category in Novice, Open or Elite jumping 4", 8", 12" or 16" are required to be (except Veteran or Junior Handler dogs jumping 16". Dogs jumping 20" are not required to be measured. Dogs in the Skilled Category or dogs with permanent height cards do not need to be measured. Dogs on the Height Exemption list do not need to be measured. Measurement forms may be obtained at <http://nadac.com/Application-for-Permanent-Height-Card.htm>.
- **Confirmations:** Correspondence for this trial is via email, please provide a valid email address. Confirmations are sent by the closing date of the trial. Final confirmations and Show Instructions will be sent prior to the trial, results after the trial. If you haven't received **an initial confirmation by July 1**, please contact the Trial Secretary to verify that your entries were received. Please read your confirmation **carefully**. If there is an error in jump height on your confirmation **you MUST** contact the trial secretary prior to **July 3rd** or you will be required to run at the jump height shown on your confirmation notice.
- Dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring. This includes all grounds in and around Soccer Blast.
- No Alcoholic Beverages are allowed on the show site.
- Handlers for a given class should be present at ring side at least one-half hour prior to the start of the scheduled classes for walk through and briefing. A dog and handler not present when they are called may be ineligible to run, unless the gate steward was notified of a potential conflict.
- Walk through and briefing will begin at 7:30 AM both days. Judging will begin at 8:00 AM both days.
- **Awards:** Placement ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth places in each jump height for each class, in each category, except Chances, which is a pass/fail class. A purple qualifying ribbon shall be given for each qualifying round in each class.
- **Pre-Trial Move-Ups:** Changes to entries or move-ups before the show accepted if received by the trial secretary in writing no later than **NOON on Monday, July 3rd**.
- **Move-Ups:** We will **not** offer day to day move-ups at this trial.

THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In addition the exhibitor who signs this agreement acknowledges that they have **read and understood the NADAC exhibitor's handbook** (available at www.nadac.com). In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1. As used here 'NADAC' means North American Dog Agility Council, Inc., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
 - 1.2. Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC, and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
 - 1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
 - 1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
 - 1.5. Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (including NADAC officers, directors, employees, and members), Minnesota Agility Club (including its officers, directors, and members, and event organizing committee), the Soccer Blast Inc. (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
 - 1.6. Exhibitor understands there is a returned check fee of \$25.
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Important Notice from NADAC

Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the www.NADACForum.com within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to www.NADACForum.com and submitting your request. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be recorded by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.
